Dear Secondary Parents,

You will have read the end of term arrangements for our school already in this week's CP letter. The final week of the first term of the 2024/2025 academic year is slightly different in both structure and style to other weeks due to a mix of special events and public holidays. The first two days – Monday 9th & Tuesday 10th December – are normal days, but school is closed on Wednesday 11th December due to a public holiday in Selangor. School resumes on Thursday 12th December, and this is also the day when we will hold our Christmas assembly. Parents are, of course, very much invited to this community event, but it is necessary to pre-register in advance, just as was the case for our recent Deepavali assembly. The most notable difference with our Christmas assembly, however, is that it will take place in the afternoon rather than in the morning, running from 13.45 – 15.15. Morning lessons up to lunchtime on Thursday will be normal, with no changes to routines or timetables. Friday 13th December will be the final day of term one, with students leaving at 12.00. There will be house events and other activities planned for Friday, but external food deliveries will not be allowed. If parents wish to make food contributions for students to eat on Friday, then they must be brought in with students in the morning and allergies should be taken into consideration. For example, food which contains nuts is not allowed.

Thank you in advance to all parents for their understanding of the above adjustments to previous routines, most of which are now in place for safeguarding reasons.

I also wish to reassure parents that, post this week's assessments, there will be no drop-off in terms of standards. Normal lessons will continue to right up to our Christmas assembly and even if the lesson content becomes lighter (which is normal in any school towards the end of a long term), the routines and expectations which keep our students safe and motivated will remain as tight as ever.
